Recycling

The Town of Imperial has ordered a single-stream recycling bin which will be placed just inside the gates of the Waste Transfer Station within the next week. It will be accessible on the days that the Waste Transfer Station is open - Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday from noon to 5 p.m.

The single stream recycling bin is for the collection of household waste packaging and paper. You do not need to sort the items but they must be placed in the bin loosely - not in a bag. Below it clearly shows how and what you can recycle in the bin. Please keep this sheet handy as an easy reference.
