2016/2017 Newsletter

A new rink season is now upon us! As we come up on this season we put to rest the 2015/2016 season. Some of the major fundraisers held at the rink were:

Imperial Rec Tournament	\$14,300 profit
Ladies Bonspiel	\$3,930 profit
Blues Spiel	\$900 profit

The above amounts do not include the profits generated by the bar (\$12,520) and the kitchen (\$11,590). Without these fundraisers the rink would not be able to operate. We ask that people continue to support fundraisers like the Rec Hockey Tourney, the Blues Spiel and the Ladies Bonspiel.

Keep the January 20th and 21st weekend open for the Rec Hockey Tournament and Casino nights. Minor Hockey day will be held January 28. The Imperial Sabres will once again be active at the rink. Be sure to come out and support the senior hockey team.

The curling ice will be in and ready to go December 1. The Ladies Bonspiel will be held March 3, 4 & 5. Watch for posters for other upcoming bonspiels.

Frank and Mary Martens will be our rink caretakers and Sharla Taylor will once again be stocking and cleaning the kitchen.

The rink is run primarily on a volunteer basis for a lot of things such as flooding early in the season, work nights and kitchen shifts. Like any small town, without people donating their time we would not be able to operate. We strongly encourage you to help out when needed. When you are scheduled for a rink kitchen shift either work it yourself or find a student to work it for you. Remember, you will only have to work a maximum of 2 kitchen shifts per rink season. As you can see above, the rink kitchen is a vital source of revenue for the rink and we need to continue with the volunteer kitchen workers. To those of you who volunteer and help out, we thank you.

This year, the Imperial Rink Committee would like to offer a recreational hockey program for youth in grades 8 and up. The program would run on Tuesday nights at 7:30. Players would wear full equipment, and the program would consist of a 30 minute practice/warm-up followed by three 20 minute periods. A referee would officiate the game. Some Watrous players have expressed an interest in joining the program. If there is
