Your help was greatly appreciated. Due to the flooding we were able to submit a claim to the Provincial Disaster Assistance Program (PDAP) for around \$69,000 and were reimbursed \$61,500.

Thank you to our volunteer firemen and to all of you who volunteer within our community.

Thank you to the Freeman Hill Snow Plow Club for donating \$1,600 toward the purchase of equipment for the fire department.
