## **Tax Discounts & Penalties Bylaw:**

The provincial government has brought in legislation that has required us to change the way in which we give discounts on tax payments. You will now receive a 5% discount only up to the end of June. Each of the following months up to November 30 must decrease. Below is a list of the discounts: Jan 1- June 30 – 5%; July 1 – July 31 – 4%; August 1 – August 31 – 3%; September 1-September 30 – 2%; October 1-October 31 – 1%; November 1 – November 30 - .5%.

**All Terrain Vehicles:**

Complaints have been received in this office regarding the operation of ATVs on the streets. ATVs cannot be operated on any street or highway, only on private property with the landowner's permission. Also, the RCMP have advised us that you must have a valid driver's licence to operate an ATV.

**Dogs:**

Dog owners please remember that you must keep your dog under control at all times. They must be confined to your yard or controlled by a leash or other such method.

**Hedges, Bushes and Trees:**

All hedges, bushes and tree branches that impede pedestrian traffic on town sidewalks need to be trimmed so that they do not impede the use of the sidewalk. Property owners are asked to do this before new growth starts this year. It is your responsibility to not let your hedge grow over the sidewalk. Failure to keep your hedge trimmed back from the sidewalks could result in the town trimming them and billing you.
