To the Residents of Imperial

The waste transfer station has been completed, a gate attendant hired and days/times established. The cost of the fence, installation and miscellaneous items was approximately \$32,000. A building and heater still need to be purchased for the attendant. The dumpsters cost the town approximately \$1,830 per month.

Shirley Flostrand has been hired to supervise the gate and collect the fees when open. Al Joa has been hired as the alternate attendant.

The gates at the transfer station will be open Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday from 12 noon – 5 p.m. Shirley will inspect your load, determine and collect the fee and direct you to the appropriate waste collection area(s). Areas (shingles, concrete, whites/metals and wood only) are marked with the appropriate signage. Please remember that the pit for “Wood Only” is for the disposal of untreated wood products; unbagged leaves; garden refuse and trees. We urge you to place these items in the pit as opposed to placing them in bags in the dumpsters as they fill the dumpsters very quickly which costs the town. We would also urge you, if possible, to haul your own leaves out to the pit. There is no fee to dispose of these items in the pit. Larger items (6’ and over) are to be placed in the large dumpster.

Please note that paint cans must be dry before they are placed in the dumpsters and that sharp metal is not to be put in the dumpsters. We would also ask you to please break down your cardboard boxes. Tires, batteries and animal carcasses are not accepted at the transfer station.

Fees for load sizes are:

1 ton truck, utility trailer or anything smaller	\$5.00
2 ton and larger trucks	25.00
Semi-truck	75.00
Shingles	.05/square foot

Special provision will have to be made for any renovation/demolition or construction materials. Contact the Town office for more information.
