

TOWN OF IMERIAL

BYLAW NO. 1/09

A BYLAW TO AQUIRE, MAINTAIN, REGULATE, CONTROL AND ESTABLISH A CEMETERY

THE COUNCIL of the TOWN OF IMPERIAL in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. The term “municipality” in this bylaw shall mean the Town of Imperial.
2. That part of the North West quarter of section 26, township 27, range 25, wet of the 2nd Meridian in the Province of Saskatchewan, acquired by the municipality for cemetery purposes as approved by the Registrar under The Cemeteries At shall be and is hereby appointed as a public cemetery to be called the Imperial Cemetery.
3. It shall be lawful for the purchaser of a lot or his agent to place markers and plant trees, shrubs and flowers thereon in accordance with the provisions of this bylaw.
4. If any tree or shrub, by means of its roots or branches or otherwise, becomes detrimental to an adjacent lot or lane, the council may direct the removal of such tree or shrub or
5. The council may direct the removal of any markers, trees, shrubs or flowers placed contrary to this bylaw.
6. It shall be unlawful to place cement tops, plastic tops, fiberglass tops, or crushed rock of any kind on lots.
7. It shall be unlawful to use any type of weed spray or soil sterilent to kill grass growing on lots.
8. The Administrator shall keep an accurate record setting forth the name, the location of burial and the date of burial of the deceased person.
9. If the Purchaser requests the municipality to open and close a grave at least one day’s notice shall be given.
10. The price of lots in the Imperial Cemetery shall be \$250.00 per single plot.
11. The purchaser of a lot shall be given a form with the description of the lot purchased. The form shall be in Form I, Appendix “A”, attached and forming part of this bylaw.
12. The following charges shall be made for the opening and closing of a grave:

Grave	\$500.00
Cremation	\$100.00
Placement of Ashes	\$ 50.00
13. Any persons found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalty provided for by the general penalty of the municipality.
14. Bylaw #8/97 is hereby repealed
