The Town of Imperial's year end is December 31. Please have all accounts paid in full. Tax payments are due by **December 31**. Late payments will incur a 15% interest charge.

### Water & Sewer Rates

Effective, January 1, 2022 the quarterly rates for water increases to \$111; sewer to \$40; and the garbage will be \$60. Quarterly bills will be \$211 assuming no overages on water.

A building permit is required for new construction; renovations, alterations and additions to existing buildings; basement development; garages and carports; decks; mobile homes; fireplaces, wood stoves and heaters; retaining walls; temporary buildings; moving a building; and demolition of a building. Permits <a href="MUST">MUST</a> be in place prior to any work starting.
