BYLAW NO. 1/03

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONTROLLING DOGS

The council of the Town of Imperial in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. Every person who owns, possesses or harbours a dog (which term shall for the purposes of this bylaw, be deemed to mean either a male or female dog) within the Town limits shall keep the dog under control at all times, and shall be considered running at large if not confined to the yard or land owned by the owner of said dog, or controlled by a leash or other such method.
- 2. In the case where a dog has bitten or attempted to bite a person, the owner or harbourer of such dog, on complaint being made, may be required, if it appears that the dog is dangerous, to have the dog destroyed.
- 3. Any person found guilty of any infraction of any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided for in the General Penalty Bylaw of the Town of Imperial.
- 4. Bylaw numbers 138 and 5/88 of the Town of Imperial is hereby repealed.
