## Recycling

The Town of Imperial has ordered a single-stream recycling bin which will be placed just inside the gates of the Waste Transfer Station within the next week. It will be accessible on the days that the Waste Transfer Station is open – Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday from noon to 5 p.m.

The single stream recycling bin is for the collection of household waste packaging and paper. You do not need to sort the items but they must be placed in the bin loosely – not in a bag. Below it clearly shows how and what you can recycle in the bin. Please keep this sheet handy as an easy reference.

We thank everyone for “thinking green” by utilizing the bin with your recycling items. If you have any questions please do not hesitate to call the office.

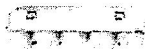

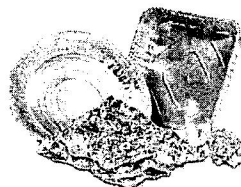

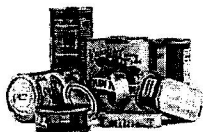

#### Follow these 3 steps:

1. Remove lids and caps from jars, bottles and cans.
2. Clean off food particles or residue. Labels can be left on.
3. Put your recyclables loose in your recycling bin. Do not put them in garbage or blue recycling bags.
4. Flatten cardboard boxes.

#### Do not include:

- Styrofoam
- Electronics
- Scrap metals
- Batteries
- Plastics without 1-7 symbol 
- Plasticized, waxed and laminated material
- Tissues/paper towel
- Mirrors, ceramics, window glass or Pyrex®
- Light bulbs
- Hazardous or bio-hazardous waste
- Wood waste
