Objective:

The objective of this policy is to establish guidelines on the use of seacan storage containers for private residents and businesses within the Town of Imperial.

Policy:

- 1. Any individual wanting to place a seacan storage container on their property must complete Schedule "A". Approval must be granted prior to placement.
- 2. Subject to Section 3, approval <u>shall</u> be granted by the municipality to use a seacan storage container as an accessory building in the following property classes:
 - Agriculture
 - Commercial
- 3. The following conditions must be adhered to:
 - The storage container must be properly anchored.
 - The storage container shall be a minimum of five (5) feet from the property line and/or twenty (20) feet from the curb.
 - The storage container must be kept in good shape and sightly as determined through inspection by Town representatives. Containers determined by the Town to be unsightly, misused, unsafe or inappropriate in any way must be removed at the owner's expense within a time period specified by the Town.
- 4. Seacan storage containers are <u>not</u> permitted in the Residential property class for longer than twenty four (24) hours.
- 5. The administration office will contact the applicant in writing as to council's approval or denial.
